 - o Books
 - Fact sheets
 - o Technical reports
 - o Magazines
 - o Brochures
- Articles available in print e.g. journals, books, fact sheets are to be referenced as the print type (not as a webpage if downloaded as an identical pdf)
- Please note that some publications (including theses) will have specific guidelines for referencing which must be adhered to for publication
- If a type of publication to be referenced does not appear in this list, please consult the communications team for further advice.
- Any resource not in print (online, radio etc) must have a date accessed in the reference.
